Accountability for the communication and effective implementation of this policy rests with the Managing Director. Our Senior Management Team is responsible for ensuring adequate resources are provided to fulfil the policy's objectives. All employees and contractors working under the supervision of Sunguard Group are individually obligated to comply with this policy and report any violations.

Sunguard Group is committed to:

- Providing a structure for setting Occupational Health & Safety (OH&S) objectives.
- Ensuring all employees and contractors possess the competence to conduct company activities.
- Continually monitoring health and safety performance against set objectives to ensure continuous improvement.
- Providing safe and healthy working conditions, maintaining equipment and machinery, and ensuring safe handling of substances to prevent work-related injuries and ill health.
- Establishing and maintaining current emergency procedures, including plans for evacuation in case of fire or other significant incidents.
- Conducting risk assessments for all our work activities.
- Instituting and maintaining a health and safety management system aligned with the principles of BS ISO 45001:2018.
- Mitigating hazards and reducing OH&S risks.
- Promoting an open safety culture, where health and safety information is freely communicated.
- Fostering a culture that encourages employee consultation, engagement, and involvement in improving health and safety.
- Prioritising health and safety equally alongside other business objectives.

















- Providing clear instructions, information, and comprehensive training to ensure employees are competent in their roles.
